## New Rabbit ECUN Panel

Nearly two years of research on ECUN serology and the applications of protein electrophoresis have ushered in this new test panel to our test offerings. This work was briefly presented at last year's AEMV meeting in Providence and is now being submitted for publication.

Our findings include the following: normal rabbits can be IgG seropositive, infected rabbits have significantly higher titers than clinically normal rabbits (average > 1:1024), and infected rabbits have significantly higher gamma globulins (by EPH). The change in the gamma fraction also results in a low A/G ratio.

The new test is available in a panel of the ELISA to determine the IgG titer and protein electrophoresis. Either 0.1 ml serum or heparinized plasma can be submitted. The panel costs \$35.
